seeks interaction, participation, access, knowledge and more citizenship.



# COMMUNICATION DURING PANDEMIC TIMES

n an emergency situation such as the one we are going through required a communicative that transcends and is assumed as a shared value, given that health as a shared value, given that health, life and wellbeing depended more than ever on the quality and efficiency of communication.

This situation obliged the public, political, private and social communication systems to dialogue, with the aim of complementing and interacting and interact, establishing links and spaces for conversations for the different moments of the emergency.

In a multicultural and diverse country, informing measures through digital, analog and printed media, was insufficient. It was necessary to consider other spaces and media that provide legitimacy, access and participation, from the territoriality and risk management approaches.

The actors responsible for policies governmental authorities had to announce, explain and, at times, to call on the public, appealing for self-care, solidarity and compliance with the health regulations in the face of a rapidly spreading virus. The weight of the information was centered on the the announcement of the daily data, through official spokespersons, and other voices represented by academics and private analysts in the media

Paying attention to the demands and needs for information and guidance on diagnostic tests, oxygen, ICU beds, access to medicines, vaccination sites, among others, was the growing concern of the entities that make up the health system. Social isolation made visible a problem that became more acute during the pandemic: **mental health**. Likewise, the painful loss of more than 200,000 Peruvians marked our lives, as did the more than 100,000 orphans.

### WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

Dialogue to analyze and evaluate the process of the pandemic, the communicative performance based on the discourses of the mediators, the information chain, influence, perceptions and responses of citizens. Likewise, to socialize what we have learned and what considerations we should take into account to generate synergies. To this end, various topics were selected, with two cross-cutting themes ethical balance and regional narratives.

For each topic, the location and selection of actors who, on the basis of questions, narrate their experiences, balance sheets, lessons learned and their perspectives.

## **IQUITOS, THE BEGINNING**

In October 2021, in the city of Iquitos, citizens gave us their stories from different perspectives, what was experienced in one of the cities most affected by the pandemic. The visions and opinions lead us to a common point: to learn in order to avoid repeating mistakes and to overcome weaknesses health and social weaknesses. They have also spoke about the initiatives of solidarity, selflessness and effort that made it possible to save lives in times of pain.
